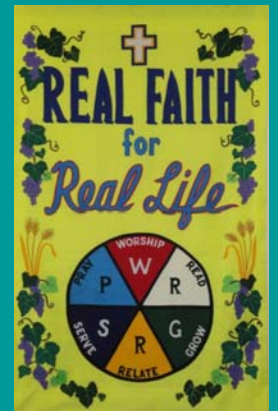

THE TRIDIUM

For several years, we've been celebrating the totality of the Tridium - the Three Days — here at Joy.

Baptism is central to Lutheran theology — not to mention Christian theology — because Baptism is rooted in the Easter mystery of death and resurrection. The two facets of the one event — death and new life — must be held together as in the rites of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil.

These form one single service, over 3 evenings, that proclaim the fullness of the mystery of the faith.

This year, Maundy Thursday will begin as we finally hear the long awaited absolution for our sins, bringing to a conclusion our Lenten observances. We will mentally and reflectively walk the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday as we ponder the mystery of Christ crucified. We will conclude this singular worship on Holy Saturday with the lighting of the new fire at sundown and hear the magnificent story of salvation history in a multi-media and participatory worship culminating in the affirmation of our Baptism and a celebration of the Easter Feast of Holy Communion.

This worship — over 3 evenings — is the most holy and ancient experience of worship uniting us to the Church and all the saints down through the ages. Please make every effort to be present each evening and experience for yourself the depth and the breadth and height of the love of God for us.

Worship on Thursday and Friday evening begins at 7:30 p.m. Holy Saturday Worship will begin at sundown, which is 8:00 p.m. this year.

Prepare for worship during Holy Week by reading through the assigned lesson prior to worship. Take some time to pray and reflect upon what God might be seeking to say to you in worship.

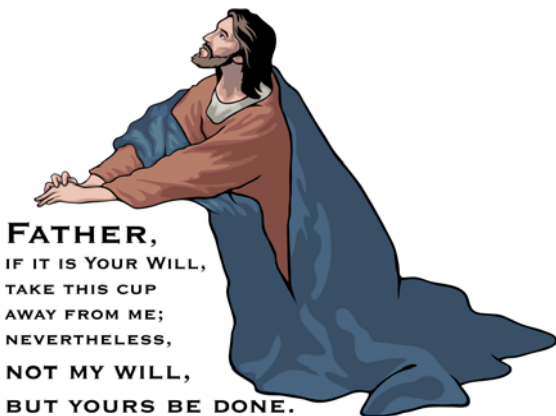
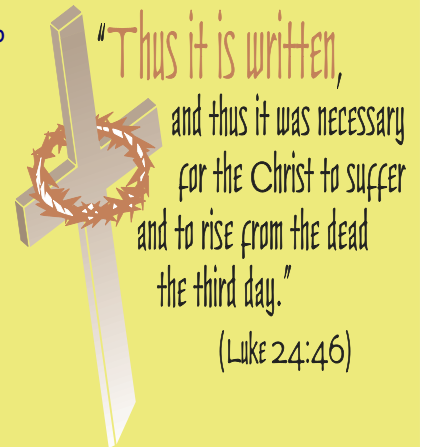

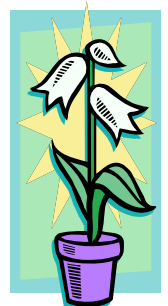

MAKING SANDWICHES FOR SHADE TREE MINISTRY!



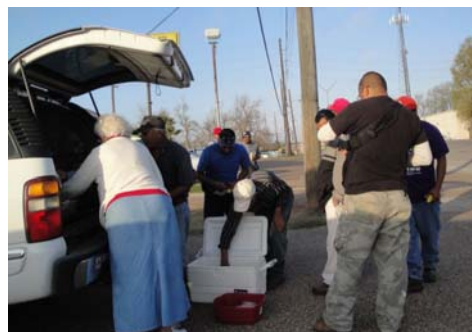

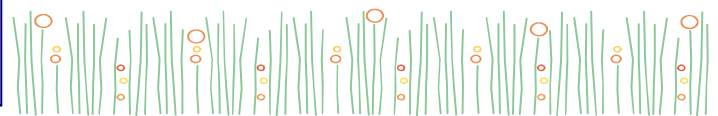

NALC establishes Ethiopia Relief Fund

March 19, 2011 — The North American Lutheran Church has established an Ethiopia Relief Fund to help Christians in western and southwestern Ethiopia who have recently experienced persecution by Islamic radicals.

The Rev. Dr. Wakseyoum Idossa, President of the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus (the Lutheran church in Ethiopia), has reported that 57 churches and 45 individual homes have been destroyed. More than 3,600 people have been displaced from their homes and some have been badly beaten and killed.

“The violence and destruction against churches of the Mekane Yesus Church and to individual Christians have largely subsided. However, the task for re-building and relief is beginning,” said NALC Bishop Paul Spring. “The Mekane Yesus Church is providing emergency assistance — food, blankets, and other necessities — for those who have experienced loss. Still ahead is the reconstruction of churches that have been destroyed.



“The North American Lutheran Church has developed a close relationship with the Mekane Yesus Church,” Bishop Spring said. “Individuals and congregations of the NALC are urged to gather funds to assist our brothers and sisters in Ethiopia.”
